



Online MSDS Retrieval System



Free Service to GCADA SAFE Members

Your Association has created an extremely efficient online MSDS retrieval system. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) provide your employees and safety personnel direction and procedures for dealing with substances in the dealership. Information on a MSDS may include but is not limited to: first aid, toxicity, health effects, storage and personal equipment. OSHA mandates that MSDSs be accessible to dealership employees as well as local fire departments and local and state emergency officials.

Getting Started...

1. Click anywhere in this message for the Program Enrollment Form. Complete it and provide it to GCADA with your current MSDSs and your SDSs. (OEM MSDSs will not be included.) MSDSs can be emailed to kford@gcada.org or mailed to the address below.
2. GCADA and DealerDocX will scan the MSDS and SDS documents and enter them into the database.
3. Login in with your GCADA issued username and password and simply enter the name of the MSDS you need. You will be able to search every participating member's MSDSs.

Have all MSDSs at your fingertips!

This service is free to all GCADA SAFE Members and is just one of the unique services provided by your Association to ensure that your dealership remains compliant with OSHA.

MSDS Format Change

Currently, all chemicals in your chemical inventory require a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS).

Effective June 1, 2015, all chemicals will require a Safety Data Sheet (SDS). Each SDS will come in a standard 16-section format so that information will be easier for employees to locate.

GCADA's new system will store MSDSs initially and transition to SDSs as they become available as the June 1, 2015 deadline approaches.
